- Be of Hispanic/Latino heritage
- Have a parent or guardian who is a member of a union

Selection Criteria

Applicants will be evaluated on the following criteria:

- Academic work
- Personal statement
- Letter of recommendation

Application Preparation

- 2) Attach a copy of your most recent high school transcript.
- 3) Complete the Personal Statement Form.
- 4) Have a teacher or guidance counselor complete the Recommendation Form.
