## **New York State Teacher of the Year**

#### Alhassan Susso United Federation of Teachers

Alhassan Susso, a government, economics and personal-development teacher at the International Community High School in the South Bronx, is the 2019 New York State Teacher of the Year.

Susso, a United Federation of Teachers member, emigrated as a teen from Gambia to the United States. Landing in Poughkeepsie without a place to stay, he was forced to live for a spell at a home-less shelter and found refuge in school. Initially, Susso entertained thoughts of going into law, but he eventually realized he could have a greater impact on the lives of young people as a teacher. He now lives in Poughkeepsie with his wife and two children, rising each day at 4 a.m. for the two-hour trip from his home to ICHS, where he has taught since 2012.

In addition to his regular teaching duties, Susso developed and leads a course during what he calls "zero period" — which begins one hour before the official school day but is nonetheless jammed with more than 60 students. The program helps his students — all of whom are immigrants from Latin American countries, Yemen, Bangladesh and nations in West Africa plan for their future by developing in them the leadership, communication and financial management skills necessary to achieve their dreams. Last year, every student who completed Susso's course graduated high school and 97 percent are enrolled in college.

Susso's experience as an immigrant who came to the United States as a teenager allows his students to connect with him on a very special personal level, since they all have shared the





same experience. Diagnosed with a rare degenerative eye condition that's left him with 20/80 vision and from which he expects to eventually go

blind, Susso also serves as an example to his students that their challenges and obstacles are not barriers to success.

## **Health Care Professionals Member of the Year**



## Raquel Webb Geddes

#### Federation of Nurses/United Federation of Teachers

Many days, you can find visiting nurse Raquel Webb Geddes tending to sick people in their homes throughout Nassau County, although her scope of practice extends far beyond those front doors.

Each week she also works for the United Federation of Teachers, traveling to sites in the five boroughs to run chapter meetings for visiting nurses in seven regions.

When the Federation of Nurses/United Federation of Teachers contract is up for renewal, she serves on the negotiating committee, keeping an eye on good working conditions to best serve nurses and patients. She has worked for the Visiting Nurse Service of New York since 1997.

Webb Geddes is also a member of NYSUT's Health Care Professionals Council, which hosts an annual professional development forum. "A team approach is best," she said.

Every year, this UFT executive board member attends NYSUT's health care lobby day to advocate for the rights of nurses and adequate patient care.

Webb Geddes's quick mind follows her quick footsteps: she has a master's degree in nursing and nursing education and a certificate in holistic nursing.

## **School-Related Professionals Members of the Year**

#### **Priscilla Castro** United Federation of Teachers

As a School-Related Professional, Priscilla Castro worked 15 years providing instructional support to medically fragile and autistic students. Castro has been a one-on-one, a crisis para, and has worked as part of an inclusion program. Her work in District 75 schools serving students with special needs took her to all five boroughs.

Castro's union involvement on the job, as a para representative and then a chapter leader, led her to a position as borough advocate for the United Federation of Teachers. Last year, in the shadow of the Janus Supreme Court case, she filled six binders with pledges from every member she visited at more than 100 sites, and every member she spoke with vowed to stick with the union.



"I made it my business! We have what we have because of the union. We started out with nothing and this is something we built over time."

She became a full-time UFT borough advocate five years ago, working with SRPs on workplace concerns. She has created a thank-you celebration for longtime paraprofessionals and a "Public School Proud" event to honor students and the educators and health care professionals who work with them.



#### Colleen Condolora Capital Region BOCES

Colleen Condolora brings her devotion to the spotlight as an SRP of the Year.

She has been a special education teaching assistant for 29 years at the Capital Region BOCES, where this Faculty Association member has put into practice a trauma-informed method of working with students. Condolora also teaches this program through NYSUT's Education and Learning Trust classes.

"We have to change our own culture to consider where the child is coming from, asking not 'What is wrong with you?' but 'What is happening to you?'" she said.

This dedicated professional has synched her commitments by

serving on NYSUT's Health and Safety Committee, where she provides workshops on traumainformed care at conferences. She is the only labor representative on her school district's health and safety committee, where she advocates for therapeutic crisis intervention; anti-bullying programs; workplace violence protection; and preventive measures vs. restraints.

Condolora, who is also a tutor, is a longtime a NYSUT delegate and a volunteer grassroots lobbyist seeking state resources for education and mental health mandates.

## "Not for Ourselves Alone:" The Sandy Feldman Outstanding Leadership Award

## Stacey Caruso-Sharpe

#### Amsterdam Teachers Association

The union awards its prestigious "Not for Ourselves Alone:" The Sandy Feldman Outstanding Leadership Award to Stacey Caruso-Sharpe of the Amsterdam Teachers Association.

The award is given annually to two women leaders who have made important contributions to the labor movement over the course of their careers.

Caruso-Sharpe has retired from teaching after 37 years, but she continues to dedicate herself to the dual causes of public education and unionism.

She became a building senator early in her career, and she became known as someone who was never afraid to speak truth to power.



Along with becoming a highly respected member of the mathematics department, and raising a family, Caruso-Sharpe worked years to fight for teachers in her home local and for all NYSUT members. She continues to represent her region on the NYSUT Board of Directors and, for many years she served as a national AFT vice president.

"Her non-stop, can-do approach ... inspired so many of her colleagues to ask what more they can do," said Eugene B. Agresta, Jr., co-president of the ATA.



#### **Evelyn DeJesus** United Federation of Teachers

The union awards its prestigious "Not for Ourselves Alone:" The Sandy Feldman Outstanding Leadership Award to Evelyn DeJesus, vice president for education and executive director of teacher centers for the United Federation of Teachers.

The award is given annually to two women leaders who have made important contributions to the labor movement over the course of their careers.

DeJesus is a member of the NYSUT Board of Directors and Executive Committee, and is a national AFT vice president. A former social worker and paraprofessional who became a skilled teacher and administrator, "she is a fierce advocate for justice and a role model for educators

of color and women in the labor movement," said UFT President Michael Mulgrew.

Educating women to lead on an educational, political and economic agenda is at the core of DeJesus's work at UFT and as chair of the AFT's Latino Issues Task Force.

In the aftermath of Hurricane Maria in 2017, she led the union's humanitarian effort to fund clean drinking water for Puerto Rico and to support the 40,000 teachers in the new AFT local there.
